IJIS Goals

- Capture data once at source event
- Electronically share data with those who need it
- Eliminate redundant data entry
- Eliminate manual distribution of data
- Notify others of special events
- Make data available instantly to those who need it for *effective decisions*

Pilot Project Purpose

- Provide a success to create synergy and support for the broader statewide integration
- Provide a learning opportunity
- Create a model for other counties to follow

Pilot Project Criteria

To provide a good test of integration

- Small enough for quick completion; large enough for proper test
- data exchanges among three or more systems of various complexity
- inclusion of a system on the state level;
- inclusion of a system that resides outside of the local area network.

Faulkner County Pilot Project

- Focus on data sharing between:
 - Faulkner County Sheriff's Office
 - 20th Judicial District Prosecuting Attorney
 - Faulkner County Circuit Clerk and Courts
 - Faulkner County Detention Facility
 - Dept. of Community Corrections
 - Dept. of Corrections

Automated Data Exchanges

- 1. Push Incident Data from Sheriff's Office to Prosecutor's Office
- Share Court Dates between Court, Detention Facility, and Prosecutor's Office
- 3. Push Bail Information from Court to Jail
- 4. Push Fine Amounts from Court to Sheriff's Office

Automated Data Exchanges

- 5. Push Attorney Assignments between Prosecutor, Court, and Jail
- 6. Push Warrant Status between Sheriff's Office, Prosecutor's Office, and Circuit Clerk
- 7. Push Judgment & Disposition and Judgment & Commitment Data from Prosecutor's Office to the Department of Corrections and Department of Community Correction

Major Accomplishments

- Upgraded the local network and hardware
- Developed detailed business rules on how to share data
- Installed Transport ManagerTM
- Developed programs to access each system's database
- Gained understanding of each agency's data and business processes

 - Subnets for each agency
















































Extra Tasks Performed

PCO

- Added new fields, tables, and forms for Incident Data
 - Narrative, Location, Date From Date Thru, Property Descriptions, Charge Descriptions, Firearm Information, Bond Amount, Release Date
- Added a Pending Flag
 - Notify Transport Manager that either a Judgment Commitment or Judgment Disposition is ready to be electronically sent to eOMIS

Extra Tasks Performed

SOMS

- Added the Agency Case Number on the Booking Charge Detail Screen
- Added a message indicating that the Incident Report has been sent to PCO
- Added an audit trail to the SOMS Booking Notes field

Extra Tasks Performed

Templar

- Created Email notifications to PCO Users for potential matching Subjects
- Linked Court Dates and Bonds to specific charges in SOMS Booking using Incident Number (agency case number).

Factors for Successful Operation

- Data Processing Office
 - Primary contact for network issues
 - Respond to issues in timely manner

- Prosecutor's Office
 - Because of the implementation delay of the new court system, the PA's Office has agreed to enter Court Date, Fines/Fees, and Attorney Assignments. This must be done in a timely manner for the IJIS system to be effective.
 - SID must be included in Judgment and Disposition/Commitment documents.

- Sheriff's Office and Detention Facility
 - It is critical that data is entered into SOMS in a timely manner for the system to be effective.
 - Must have Incident Number and Arrest Tracking Number when booking in suspects
 - Each charge in the booking record must have an incident number
 - Warrant number should be entered when booking in suspects

- ALL Agencies
 - Virus protection
 - Security
 - User IDs and confidential passwords
 - No modem connections on workstations
 - Keep current on software and hardware
 - Upgrade to Windows XP
 - Replace slow workstations
 - Implement a 3 year workstation upgrade plan
 - COMMUNICATE!

What's Next?

- Add more data exchanges!
 - Send prosecutor charging decisions to SOMS
 - Add Hot Checks processing
 - Send juvenile incidents and bookings from Sheriff to Juvenile RMS
- Add Conway Police Department
- Add other municipal police departments
- Expand to entire 20th Judicial District
- Include JIS when it becomes operational
- Add Public Defenders
- Send disposition, warrant, and protection order data to ACIC
- Install InformantTM
